

We are delighted to announce the **Junior-Eunethydis annual meeting 2022, on the 30 September 2022**. The conference will be a unique opportunity for early career investigators in the field of ADHD to present their research to peers and receive feedback/advice from senior Eunethydis members.

A reduced fee for the registration will be applied. Particularly, the 10 best junior abstracts / posters/presentations will have a chance to be awarded a travel stipendium.

### ***Application Guidelines***

1. “Early career Investigators” are 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> year Ph.D. students, trainees in (child and adolescent) psychiatry, psychology or related disciplines actively involved in research, or Post-Doctoral Fellows who are within 3 years of completing their Ph.D.
2. Eligible Early career Investigators are those who are supervised by a member of Eunethydis and whose research is relevant to ADHD
3. Eligible applicants must be able to come in person to present their work as an oral presentation or poster (based on the outcome of the selection by the Scientific committee)
4. All applications will be reviewed by the Selection Committee (listed below) using the following criteria:
  - a. The applicant’s Abstract:
    - i. Indicates innovative and scientifically-sound research;
    - ii. Reports the objectives, hypotheses, methods, results, and conclusions clearly and succinctly
  - b. The applicant’s CV
    - i. Provides evidence of excellent background training for the research being undertaken
    - ii. Provides evidence of a good track record in both academic (e.g., awards, presentations, publications) and collaborative endeavours (e.g., scientific, volunteer, or community-based activities).

### ***Required application documents***

1. A 300-word abstract describing the research to be presented
2. A Curriculum Vitae
3. A brief cover letter (one paragraph) in which you indicate the name of your Research Supervisor and explain what you hope to contribute and gain from attending the Eunethydis International Meeting.
